The aim of the MA Logistics course is to train professionals who possess managerial skills to support project management in different sectors. More specifically, this master's course focuses on training professionals, such as Logistics and Supply Chain Managers, for companies and agencies globally.

This BSBI programme can be taught in either Berlin or Barcelona, or you could start in Barcelona and finish in Berlin. The programme is accredited by UNINETTUNO. BSBI is partnered with CETT Barcelona School of Tourism, Hospitality and Gastronomy. This MA programme can be taught at CETT's campus in Barcelona or at BSBI's campus in Berlin.

This programme consists of three terms (10 weeks each) and a term focused on your dissertation (12 weeks). Teaching takes place Monday to Saturday, during morning, afternoon, or evening sessions.

The modules of this programme are offered and delivered 100% on campus. Students will also have additional access to course and reading materials via the UNINETTUNO platform.

You will also attend modules on study and academic research methods and study the German language alongside your master's degree subjects. During your final term, you will research and prepare a dissertation on a topic of your choice.

What will you experience?

Among expected results, there is the acquisition of economic-managerial tools and skills aimed at cooperation during the logistics project and its execution phases. The role of the Logistics Executive focuses on developing the skills needed to check the progress of building supply chains and detect any problems to be dealt with, as it regards both project progress and the quality of production as well as organisation.

Why study this course?

The master's course envisages the training of professional profiles such as Logistics and Supply Chain Managers and Executives for companies and agencies working globally higher education institution to another.

European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS)

You will earn a master's degree with 90 ECTS. This helps student mobility in the EU when it comes to transferring credits from one higher education institution to another.

Who should take this course?

This master's course is for students who have earnt a three-year university degree in a course in the Engineering Faculty or in the field of Economic Sciences or Statistical Sciences.

Entry Requirements

Minimum age: 21 years old

Academic qualifications:

- A three-year bachelor's degree from a recognised institution in a related discipline.
- High-school certificate

If you do not have a bachelor's degree, but you have another academic qualification such as an HND or a Level 5 Diploma and/or professional experience, you are also welcome to apply. Your acceptance may be subject to successfully sitting an entrance exam and an interview.

English Language

- IELTS 6.0 (no less than 5.5 in any component), equivalent Password Test, PTE Academic (both in test centre and online accepted) 50 + score, TOEFL IBT or equivalent (e.g. Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), Trinity's Integrated Skills in English (ISE): ISE I (B1) for BAF with *Pass in each component; ISE II (B2) for all Master and BA courses with *Pass in each component; ISE III (C1) for DBA with *Pass in each component
- English proficiency requirements can be waived for:

- Native English speakers, applicants who completed their education in English (such as a high school diploma or IB).
- Applicants who completed their undergraduate degree in English in an English-speaking country.
- o Medium of Instruction letter for a qualification awarded within the last 5 years.
- o West African Senior School Certificate (WAEC) as proof of English for applicants from West Africa, namely Nigeria, Ghana, Liberia, Gambia and Sierra Leone (with conditions*).
- WAEC English Language component must be at level C6 or above.

Spanish Language

- B2 level of the common European framework
- Spanish proficiency requirements can be waived for:
 - Native Spanish speakers, applicants who completed their education in Spanish (such as a high school diploma or IB)
 - Applicants who completed their undergraduate degree in Spanish in an Spanish-speaking country
