



If English is not your first language you'll need to submit evidence that your proficiency in the English language meets the required level for your course, such as IELTS at the appropriate grade.

You can complete a free English language test with us directly if you wish. Our test uses the same grading system as the IELTS, and you'll typically receive your results in just a couple of days.

Getting started on your career path

How to apply

We try to make the application process as straightforward as possible. We also have multiple intakes throughout the year, so once you apply, you'll be studying with us before you know it

- 1** To begin the application process, please contact your representative who will help you with everything you need to get started.
- 2** Our admissions team will then process your application to determine if you're eligible for your course of interest.
- 3** If your application is successful, you'll receive an offer of a place on the course from us, detailing the next steps to take to start your degree.
- 4** **You'll become part of the Arden community!**

Entry Requirements

For most courses at Arden, we accept the following entry requirements. Please note: some courses might have their own specific requirements, so you'll need to double-check the website for more details.

Undergraduate

To be eligible for our undergraduate courses, you will need either:

- Two subjects at A-level or equivalent, plus three passes at grade C or above at GCSE level or equivalent;

OR

- Completed a recognised Access Programme or equivalent.

OR

- Applicants may be considered based on a minimum of 12 months of professional work experience evidenced with a CV and Reference
- Bsc (Hons) Accounting & Finance requires GCSE maths at grade C or equivalent

Undergraduate with foundation year

To be eligible for our undergraduate courses, you will need either:

- At least three GCSEs or equivalent that are less than 3 years old,

OR

- At least three GCSEs or equivalent, over 3 years old, with an accompanying CV

- Applicants may be considered based on a minimum of 12 months of professional work experience evidenced with a CV and Reference

Postgraduate

To be eligible for postgraduate courses, you will need either:

- A UK Honours degree at a minimum of second class (2.2) or equivalent.
- For MBA we require at least two years of work experience
- For MBA (Graduate) work experience is not required.

English proficiency For undergraduate, and postgraduate courses:

IELTS 6.0 (no less than 5.5 in any element); or TOEFL iBT 60-78; or equivalent

For Foundation courses:

ELTS 5.5 (no less than 5.0 in any element); or TOEFL 46-59; or equivalent

Alternatively, evidence you have previously studied in English, such as a letter to show that the Medium of Instruction was in English can be accepted. We also offer an internal English test for applicants who are unable to provide the above evidence of English proficiency.

Do you have work experience, but not the qualifications?

At Arden University we are more than happy to consider, and positively encourage, an application from you if you have substantial management experience (typically 5 years) and can show us that you have the motivation to study the programme.

We'll ask you for a personal statement that demonstrates your ability to study your master's course. We may also want references and evidence of relevant work experience.years).
